During 2006 Springs Hill Water has completed a new 750,000 gallon elevated storage tank located on Oak Tree Road in Hickory Forest subdivision. This tank was completed in August 2006 and filled with water and in service September 1st 2006. This new tank will better serve our system the old standpipe had approximately 300,000 gallons of which only 100,000 gallons could be used. The new tank will increase the pressure in that area of our system and will provide many more hours of available water to system and allow the well field some rest time.

Also in 2006 Springs Hill Water installed eight miles of twelve inch water main and has two new river crossing on the Guadalupe River. The river crossings are on FM 466 and FM 1117, now we can better move water within our system.

During 2006 a twelve inch main was completed along Rudeloff Road from Lake Ridge subdivision south under the railroad tracks and FM 78 and connecting to a major water main along FM 1620. With the improvements Springs Hill Water has completed during 2006 we can now move water throughout our system and better serve our Owner/Members.

There have been many new subdivisions proposed in our CCN and several have started building new homes.
