Springs Hill broke ground on the expansion of the Lake Placid Water Treatment Plant which will double our capacity to produce water from 1.0 mgd to 2.0 mgd. This project will also provide us with a second track for processing. This means when something goes wrong with the current system we will not have to turn the plant off but can depend on the new infrastructure. This expansion will help us keep up with the growth in our CCN. This contract went to Holloman Corporation and several local people including members of our system will be working on the job site.

The second contract was awarded to RLN, James Nightingale who is also a member of the Springs Hill Water Group. He will be replacing some of the oldest lines in the system. These lines were made of AC pipe or Asbestos Concrete Pipe. This part of our system often experiences breaks and leaks.

CONSERVATION Springs Hill front lawn will be getting a makeover with the help of the Guadalupe County Master Gardeners. Volunteers from that organization have designed a demonstration garden and will be putting it in place in the near future. It will be a colorful Xeriscape garden. We will have signage and a short walking path. In the future we hope all of you will enjoy the space and learn more about low water requirements. You will also be able to learn about the plants on our Web site.
